I don't blame you...it's exciting! You don't have to hide your excitement, but keep in mind that there might be some folks that are pretty sad over the cast list, too. You've probably been there before...don't post or say anything you wouldn't have wanted to read or hear!

Think about what you say before you do. Speaking negatively of the department because you aren't happy with the outcome of auditions not only isn't helpful...a poor attitude could have an impact on your future casting/crew positions.

If it helps, find a trusted friend and hash it out with them! There's nothing wrong with talking through something...just stay positive!

You're allowed to be excited, so if you change your mind, just re-answer the question!

Do you want to talk to the director about the decisions?

Yep!

Nope.

Regardless of how you feel about the company list, you must wait 24 hours from the time it is posted to talk about it with the director. At that time, here are a few appropriate questions that you can ask:

- Were there any factors that went into my placement that it would be helpful for me to know about?
- In the next production, I'd like to be considered for _____. What could I do to prepare for that in the meantime?
- What are some specific things I can do to continue learning and growing?
